The featured speaker will be our Immediate Past President Maria D'Andrea-Yothers who will give a presentation on the *transumanza* and *traturri*, a phenomenon that has profoundly influenced the economy, culture, and history of Abruzzo and Molise. The *transumanza* refers to the seasonal transfer of sheep between the green pastures of the higher Apennines in Abruzzo and Molise in summer to the green plains of Puglia and Lazio in winter. The routes followed by the shepherds are known as *tratturi*. In what is sure to be an informative presentation, Maria will illuminate this pivotal aspect of our regional identity. The cost is \$35 for members and \$40 for non-members. **Paid reservations must** be received by 12 noon on September 19; the online reservation system will close at 11:45 p.m. on September 18.
